

## Tuition

Fine Arts @ the Beach tuition covers all lessons, administrative expenses, and salaries. Recital expenses and lesson books are not covered by tuition. An accompanist fee is charged for vocal students.

- 👉 Registration Fee – \$15.00
- 👉 Tuition for 30 minute lesson – \$250
- 👉 Tuition for 45 minute lesson – \$380
- 👉 Tuition for Master Classes to be announced

These fees are semester fees and may be broken down into 4 convenient payments with prior approval. The monthly rate is for the convenience of parents and is not related to the number of lessons in a particular month.

- 👉 Summer tuition 30 min lessons – \$85
  - 👉 Summer tuition 45 min lessons – \$127.50

## Goals and Philosophy

Fine Arts @ the Beach is a ministry of Gulf Beach Baptist Church. It functions under the umbrella of the Music, Worship, & Arts Ministry and serves the church by:

It is our desire to provide the best in fine arts instruction. We are dedicated to creating an atmosphere where students can learn fine arts, grow spiritually and use their talents to glorify our Creator.

## Instrument Policy

A student should be able to practice on an instrument that facilitates progress. Guitars and violins should be fitted to the individual and may need upgrading as the child grows. Piano students may begin on a keyboard; however, it is recommended that piano students have an instrument with a weighted keyboard, or an acoustic piano. The director and teachers will be happy to recommend dealers for new, used, or rental instruments.

When available, a student may check out an instrument from our library, as well as, music, and audio tracks

## Registration and Policies

To begin the enrollment process, new students must contact the director, complete a registration form and enrollment agreement, and submit them with the first month's tuition on or before the registration deadline. When a student is enrolled, he/she is committing to an entire semester of study.

## Lessons & Scheduling

To provide consistency and an atmosphere conducive to learning, all Academy lessons are taught at GBBC. **No exceptions.** During the enrollment process, each student will be assigned an instructor. The student or parent of the student will then be contacted to confirm a convenient lesson or class time. Once a lesson time is established, it is important that the student continue through the semester with that time. We face many challenges coordinating lessons, space, lesson times, and instructors.

## Make Up Policy

We consider your private lesson time as a standing appointment. If the teacher has to miss a lesson, it will be made up. If the student misses a lesson, **PRIOR NOTICE IS REQUIRED.** Twenty-four hour notice is preferable. However, if a student wakes up ill on a lesson morning, please call the [instructor](#), or the music office by 9:00am @ 850.234.8892 ext 218 or 228. Please leave a voicemail with students name, instructor, and time/day of the lesson if we are away from the desk. All cancellations and reschedules must be recorded in the music office.

## End of Semester Recitals

It is important for students to hear other students play/sing, or express their arts in their field of study. There is also great value in students' performing in public. Therefore, each student will be required to attend and participate on the end of the semester recital and should plan to remain for the entire time.

Instructors will guide each student in this process, so they will have a positive experience

Fall semester is "Semester A & C" and spring semester is "Semester B & D." Each semester will close with a recital in every area of study. The "D" semester will focus on a collective performance thus each area of study will have an additional interest towards this project. In the areas of art and media, they will display their work in the west Wing.

## Enrollment and Instruction

Private lessons are offered on a weekly basis in 30 or 45 minute blocks. Advance lessons in piano are available with permission from the instructor and Academy director. Vocal instruction is offered to grade school through adults. The Early Beginner voice students will be enrolled into the program through evaluation only.

Classes offered in group participation are based with a minimum enrollment required. See the director for details.
