Misti Roberts began dancing at the age of three. At age eight, she joined a prestigious performing arts studio in Memphis, Tennessee, where she studied dance under the direction of Elizabeth Anne Brown and voice under the direction of Cindy Barrett. She continued her training at various dance camps from Atlanta to New York. She majored in dance performance at Oklahoma City University under the direction of Jo Rowan.

Misti's dancing can be seen in the movie "Great Balls of Fire" with Dennis Quaid and in the music video "Class of 55:" with Carl Perkins. Misti was also featured in "Golden Slippers" with the Memphis Dance Alliance at Memphis State University. She has performed at the historic Orpheum Theater in the opera "Hansel and Gretel" and "A Tribute to Martin Luther King." Misti was also a member of American Spirit Dance Company in Oklahoma. She appeared in numerous musicals, as a dancer in "West Side Story" and playing such roles as Pepper in the musical "Annie" and Peggy in "42nd Street." She has danced in several original productions and has worked with choreographers from Atlanta to Los Angeles. Misti also choreographed several musicals and dance performances in Atlanta and Cleveland, Ohio.

Misti's teaching experience began at a small studio in Oklahoma City in 1991. In Atlanta (1993-1997), she taught ballet, jazz, and tap to 122 children in 13 different classes, ages 3-18. After moving to Cleveland, Ohio (1997-2002), Misti founded and directed a small worship dance company as a ministry of her church. The dancers participated in worship services at churches and performed at various other venues, in an effort to bring the good news of Jesus to those who would not normally attend church.
